Because Monument, Orviston, Beech Creek, and Howard all had brickyards, which collectively made Clinton and Centre Counties – the refractory brick capital of the world. The Bricktown Challenge is one of our attempts to raise some funds directly for the effort, yet more importantly raise awareness of the greenway and develop regional support and fundraising.

This event on July 12th is for families and friends to come out and have some fun. We hope to bring the communities together for this day and also raise awareness about the Bricktown Trail project.
